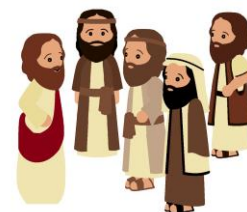

To do this, staff make the most of every opportunity within an already very crowded curriculum. Please can we remind parents that school registration opens at 8:30am and closes at 8:45am. Learning opportunities begin as soon as children enter their classroom. If a child is even just 5 minutes late, it can impact their resilience and impact on the time they need to feel ready to access their learning. Arriving just 5 minutes late every day, equates to 3 days' worth of learning time lost over the school year. Thank you to those who continually arrive on time. If you are finding it challenging to ensure your child is in school by 8:45am, please let us know and we are happy to support how and where we can.

## NSPCC ROCKS!



February 3rd is NSPCC Number Day! As part of our commitment to make maths exciting and high profile in our school, we've decided to take part in a friendly competition involving schools in the United Kingdom. It's a 1-day competition which starts on Friday 3rd February 2023 at 07:30 GMT and ends at 19:30 GMT. It's all done online via [play.ttrockstars.com](https://play.ttrockstars.com)

Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours, subject to a 60-minute limit (see below)). Winning classes in the school, and in the competition, will be the ones with the highest average.

To support player wellbeing, there is a time limit of 60-minutes per player. In other words, each player can earn competition points for up to 60-minutes between 07:30 GMT and 19:30 GMT on Friday 3rd February. Once the player goes beyond 60-minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition.
