Theme

During this term, the children's work will be based around 'Where the Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak

Hook: The room being changed into another place (as in the book)

Marvellous Middle: Designing monsters

Fantastic Finish: A Wild Thing rumpus

In **Literacy** we will be learning about:

- Story writing
- Drama
- Poetry

In **Science** we will be learning about:

- Seasonal Change

In **DT**, we will be making food for the rumpus

In **Computing**, Y2 will be working on data and programming. Y1 will be working on mouse control

In **Art**, we will be drawing and making collage.

SPaG

This term, the areas we will focus on within phonics, handwriting and **SPaG** (grammar, punctuation and spelling) are:

- Common exception words
- Letter formation
- Spaces between words
- Sentence structure
- Full stops and capital letters (including proper nouns)
- Word classes (nouns, verbs and adjectives)

Mathematics

- **Place Value** – counting forwards and backwards; reading and writing numerals and words; one more and one less; comparing and ordering numbers
- **Addition and Subtraction** – number bonds; using concrete objects, pictures and mental recall; add and subtract one and two digit numbers
