In our Collective Worship on Monday we explored with the children the meaning of the Christingle and the special symbolism that each part holds for Christians around the world. - The orange represents the world
- The red ribbon (or tape) symbolises the love and blood of Christ
- The sweets and dried fruit represent all of God's creations
- The lit candle represents Jesus' light in the world, bringing hope to people living in darkness

It was a beautiful service and very moving to see 123 children circled around the Church with the candles lit and their families sitting in the centre.
