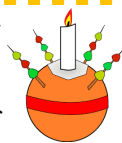

We would like to invite all parents/carers to our Christingle Service at Wittersham Church on Friday 2nd February at 2.00pm.

Christingle means 'Christ's Light' and it is a symbol of the Christian faith. The custom of giving out lighted candles in these services originates from the Moravian Church but was introduced to the Anglican Church in 1968. 'Christingles' are made up of different parts, each one being there to remind us of something. The orange represents the world whilst the candle is to remind us that Christians believe Jesus to be the light of the world. The red ribbon represents the blood of Jesus. The four cocktail sticks could have either of two meanings: the four seasons or the four corners of the world. The sweets are to remind us of God's gifts to the world including kindness and love.

We would kindly ask parents to send their children in with an orange by Tuesday 30th January.
