Limiting the Cost of School Uniform

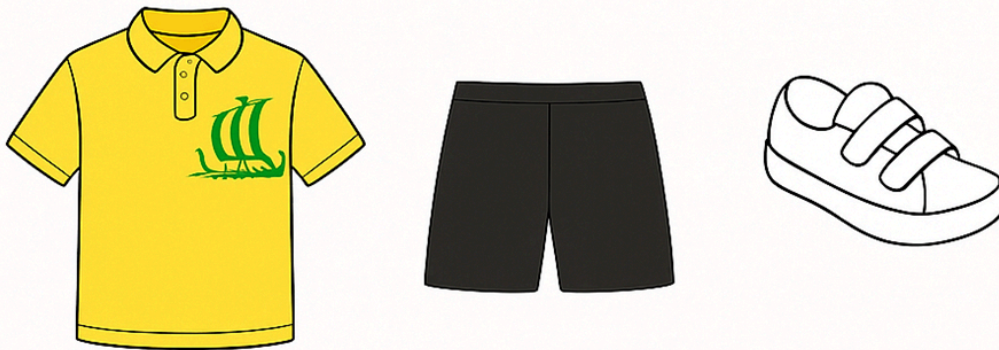
In line with Department for Education guidance, we ensure our uniform is affordable. We:

- Keep branded/logo items to a minimum
- Offer options for plain alternatives where possible
- Provide opportunities for parents to purchase second-hand uniforms
- Avoid unnecessary changes to specifications that create additional costs
- Ensure that our uniform acts as a social leveller

Everyday Uniform

Item	Colour / Details
Shirt / Blouse	White
Polo Shirt / T-shirt	White
Sweatshirt / Jumper / Cardigan / Fleece	Dark Green (school logo items available)
Skirt / Pinafore / Trousers	Grey
Shorts	Grey
Summer Dress	Green and white checks or stripes
Socks / Tights	Grey, Black or White
Shoes	Black, sensible school shoes (no trainers)
PE Polo Shirt	Yellow (school logo items available)
PE Shorts / Skorts	Black
PE Footwear	Plimsolls or trainers (Velcro preferred for Windmills/Smugglers)
PE Tracksuit Bottoms	Plain black
PE Hoodie / Sweatshirt	Plain black or green (school logo green hoodies accepted)

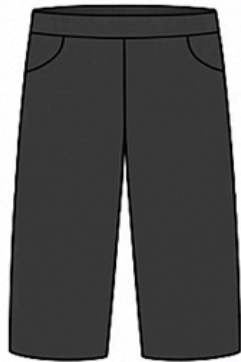

Important Notes

- All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Shoes must have Velcro or buckle fastenings unless your child can tie their own laces.
- Earrings, if worn, must be plain studs only.
- Younger children should also bring a labelled spare set of uniform, as we go outside in all weathers.
- All children must have a pair of wellies that can be left in school all year round.
- Please also provide gloves, a scarf, and a woolly hat during colder months.

Jewellery, Hair, and Appearance

- Jewellery is not allowed except plain ear studs, which must be removed for PE.
- Hair accessories should be simple and plain; large decorations are not permitted.
- Make-up, nail varnish, and extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school.

Footwear

- Children must wear plain black shoes (no logos, platforms, or high heels).
- Plain black boots may be worn in colder weather.

Role of Parents

Parents are responsible for ensuring their child:

- Wears the correct uniform and PE kit, clean and in good condition
- Has all items clearly labelled with their name
- Where difficulties arise, parents are encouraged to contact the school confidentially to discuss support.

Role of Governors

The Governing Body supports the headteacher in implementing the school uniform policy and ensures that it is fair, inclusive, and affordable for all families.
