#### English

#### Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar – Year 5

Spelling –cious or –tious endings, -cial or –tial, -ant, -ance/-ancy, -ent, -, -ence/--ency, -able, -ible, -ably and –ibly

Convert nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes, -ate, -ise, -ify

Revision of grammar including degrees of possibility, commas to avoid ambiguity and brackets, dashes or commas to indicate parenthesis

#### Year 4

Spelling suffixes -ation, -ous, words spelt sc. Revision of homophones, apostrophes for possession and contraction, shun endings.

Revision of grammar to include fronted adverbials, use of commas and word types.

#### Maths

Year 4 – decimals, measurement, time, statistics, geometry (properties of shape and position and direction)

Year 5 – decimals and percentages, multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000, geometry (properties of shape and position and direction), measurement – converting units, volume

All lessons include aspects of reasoning and problem solving.

PE these sessions will be on Thursday and Friday of each week so a full kit must be in school. In addition, our swimming pool slots will also be on Thursday and Friday.
